

Collage “Safe Internet”

Equipment: colored magazines, printed images, white paper, markers or pencils.

Instructions:

Recall with your child the basic rules of safe use of the Internet, find pictures that are associated with these statements (provided after the exercise), or draw your own pictures - create a single collage. This "picture" can be a good reminder of Internet security for every day!

Basic rules for children for safe use of the Internet:

1. Add to "friends" only those people whom you know in real life;
2. It is better to have “private” page in social networks;
3. Do not reply in private messages to strangers;
4. Do not provide private information: home address, phone number, school number where you are studying and / or addresses of after-school activities, login and password from the personal page;
5. It is better not sharing your geolocation, but you also shouldn't share it in the place you live, study and usually stay;
6. Do not send your intimate photos in private messages to those whom you already know, or to those with whom you have met on the Internet.
